 - The visits may be made to any Lodge meeting within the Jurisdiction.
 - The Lodge you intend to visit may not be performing any ceremonial work. However this will still count towards your total and should not deter you from visiting.
 - It would be advantageous to have your Mentor or Nominator with you to advise and guide you.
 - If you are going alone to a Lodge it would be better to check beforehand regarding the Tying time.
 - To assist you in the task ask your Lodge Secretary for a copy of the District Diary.
 - It is a further requirement that you observe a demonstration of the First Tracing Board before taking your Third Degree (preferably before taking the Second Degree). Ask your Mentor or the Master for details.
